Debuting directly into Marriott's choice selection of one-of-a-kind hotels - the Autograph Collection - the Kameha Grand Zurich showcases a beguiling mix of playful architecture, stylish fusions and thematic interiors that could only come from the mind of Marcel Wanders.

Ensconced in Zurich's Glattpark, this Kameha Grand, while 215 key, emits a playfulness and flourish that one would more likely associate to a boutique offering. Playful themes as evidenced in the Poker Face Suite, one of eleven uniquely decked suites to carry its own distinct character.



As its name would suggest, the Poker Face Suite carries casino-esque highlights - think roulette tables and Kameha brand poker cards - as does the Gentleman Suite, pictured above.

A significantly lower-stakes time can be found in the Serenity Suite, where wellness and tranquility take priority.



International influences can be found in the hotel's many social spaces and eateries. Two restaurants presenting distinct culinary profiles - L'Unico, for authentic Italian cuisine and Yu Nijyo, for masterfully prepared sushi dishes - sate appetites, while The Puregold Bar dazzles with its gold-set back bar, framing the hotel's main daytime and evening space.



A more sedentary pace can be found in the Cigar Lounge and Shisha Lounge, while a sense of peace and tranquility can be sought at the Kameha Spa.
