This incredible 245 room hotel opened in March 2015 after two years of contruction. It was designed by world-famous Dutch designer Marcel Wanders who became known by his iconic Knotted Chair. His intention was to develop a space that would become a tourist attraction in itself, he didn't fail. The hotel is a special treat to design and architecture buffs. The space suite is not the only awe-inspiring one, there are 11 individually designed themed suites, one more interesting than the other. Swiss chocolate lovers will find the King Kameha Suite irresistible. This striking suite showcases a series of Swiss inspired elements including Swiss chocolate walls and 'Swiss Vault' minibars with a selection of delicious Swiss goodies. While the Gentleman Suite features a roulette table and a globe as a whisky trolley, the Workout Suite allows guests to exercise any time of the day or night with a personal treadmill, exercise bench and yoga mats.

Their public spaces are equally refreshing. They have a cigar lounge as well as a Shisha lounge with a comprehensive collection of Arabic Shisha and tobacco. It's an indulging, hedonistic experience for the senses with tactile fabrics, sensual colours and atmosphere.

The hotel exudes creativity and innovation that goes far beyond design. From November 2015, every Saturday from 2pm guests will be transported into a world of sweet temptation in the shape of a chocolate buffet created by their Pastry Chef Attila. They have a white truffle menu (not dishes, a whole menu) and special sake evenings with invited sake connoisseurs and premium breweries.
