

It's only been a few months since the opening of Kameha Grand Zurich, an Autograph Collection Hotel. a design hotel that had us smiling right out of the gate, with its bold Swiss red-on-white palette, chocolate bar walls, and "Puregold" bar.

Now there's more to love - and more rooms coming to choose from - as Dutch born Wanders signs his "autograph" on 11 individually-themed suites.

The design of the suites covers a range of styles, passions and personality traits. Somewhere in the design mix, guests can ideally find their "lieblingsplatz" (favorite place,) the Kameha mantra.

Three of the suites are now available for booking, with the remaining eight to be completed over the following months. In the mean time, here are six of the eleven suites to "wander" though.



1. The Oriental Suite: This Asian-inspired suite is totally "wanderized," with its oversized patterned rug, classic chandelier, chocolate bar sliding walls, and sleek modern furnishings.


2. The Burlesque Suite: This is not your mother's burlesque suite, although there's the prerequisite red in the drapes and abstract floral rug, black leather and lace (in the headboard and lamp) and floor-to-ceiling mirrors.



5. The Serenity Suite (also shown in the opening rendering): A little Swiss zen in this soothing,

"no worries" suite, predominantly in cool white, with books on health to get you in the mood, and a yoga mat to get you on the floor.
