All around are hovering astronauts, pictures of galaxies, three of Najjar's original artworks and models of rockets. There is even a bookshelf stacked high with spacerelated literature and an Apple TV with more than 20 movies related to space. The bed is designed to appear as if it is floating, and the sheets are black, paying homage to the monolith from 2001: A Space Odyssev.

With a kitchenette: a walk-in wardrobe, as well as a steam bath and rain shower in the bathroom, this is a micro universe you may never want to leave.
